Ring Size Guide

There are two (2) secure and easy methods to find your ring size

Method 1

Use your own ring

Find your own ring that fits exactly on your fingers. Then measure its inside diameter with a bending ruler. Check the size on the ruler. Then go to the Size Chart where you will find the column "Diameter" and search for the "inside diameter" that corresponds to your measurement. In the next column is written the number that corresponds to your inner diameter. For example if the inside diameter measurement is 17.3 mm then your number is 54.

Method 2

Measuring the circumference of your finger

You will need a rope or ribbon and wrap it around the finger where the ring is to be worn and it should be neither too loose nor too tight on the finger. Once the two (2) ends are applied, mark their point of contact with a marker. Then open the ribbon and with a ruler measure the distance between the two (2) ends in millimeters. Then in the Size Chart you will find the column "Circumference" and search for the length that corresponds to your measurement.
